Air Quality Operating Permit

for Indian Basin Gas Plant of OXY USA WTP Limited Partnership

OXY USA WTP Limited Partnership at 5 Greenway Plaza Suite 110; Houston, TX 77046 is requesting the re-opening of Title V Operating Permit P103R3 for this facility, TEMPO Agency Interest ID No. 197. The owner of this plant is OXY USA WTP Limited Partnership. The exact location of the facility is at latitude 32 deg, 27 min, 50.03 sec and longitude -104 deg, 34 min, 26.82 sec, Datum: WGS84. To aid in locating this facility, the approximate location is 14.5 miles west of Carlsbad, NM in Eddy County. This application file has been assigned an Operating Permit Number P103R3M1.

The Department is re-opening this operating permit to correct a material mistake made in establishing the terms or conditions of the previous permit in accordance with 20.2.70.405.A(1)(c) NMAC. Per 20.2.70.401.C(4) NMAC, the subject operating permits are revised to correct monitoring and recordkeeping for newly imposed requirements. There are no changes to the existing air emission limits or applicable regulations under this re-opening. Therefore, the preliminary intent of NMED is to issue the air quality operating permit on or before July 21, 2021.

Interested persons may obtain the draft operating permit, submit written comments, or request a public hearing on Operating Permit Number P103R3M1 by contacting Joseph Kimbrell at the New Mexico Environment Department, Air Quality Bureau, 525 Camino de los Marquez Suite 1, Santa Fe, NM 87505-1816.

Written requests for public hearing must state the nature of the issues proposed to be raised in the hearing. Comments must be based on the requirements of the applicable state and federal air quality regulations and the Clean Air Act. Comments or hearing requests must be received within 30 days after the public notice is published.

The permit application, draft permit and relevant supporting materials are currently available for review at the Air Quality Bureau, 525 Camino de los Marquez Suite 1, Santa Fe, NM 87505-1816.
