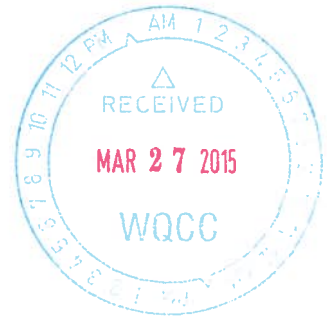

**ORDER**

This matter came before the Hearing Officer on *The New Mexico Environment Department's Motion for Leave To File Amended Notices of Intent To Present Technical and Rebuttal Testimony* (the "Motion"). After considering the Motion, the New Mexico Attorney General Office's Objections, and all other relevant documents, the Hearing Officer finds the Motion should be granted in part, and denied in part. Specifically, the Hearing Officer finds and orders that:

1. Given the unforeseen circumstances, it is reasonable to allow Trais Kliphuis from the New Mexico Environment Department to adopt, with modifications and amendments, the technical testimony and any rebuttal testimony already submitted by Jerry Schoepner.
2. Ms. Kliphuis will not be permitted to offer new or supplemental testimony, as there is not adequate time for the other parties to fully evaluate additional testimony and offer rebuttal testimony.
3. In order to address the expert substitution, the Hearing Officer will grant the parties latitude during cross-examination on issues related to Ms. Kliphuis qualifications, expertise and amendments.
4. The Hearing Officer will also entertain objections and motions to strike regarding Ms. Kliphuis's qualifications and/or testimony during the hearing.
